Core home care (personal, homemaking, companionship)	\$38/hr
Specialized support (dementia, post-hospital, palliative)	\$45/hr
Overnight sleeping shift (8–10 hrs)	\$280–350/night
Live-in care (24/7 caregiver present)	\$8,500/month
Initial nursing assessment (60–90 min)	\$120 flat
Follow-up nursing visit (30–45 min)	\$110 flat
<b>Specialized skilled visit</b> (wound vac, complex wound)	<b>Starting at \$80/hr</b>
